Please be reminded, so to help stop the spread of germs, we ask that if your child has been sick or had diarrhoea, that they are kept off school for 48 hours following the last episode.

Gentle Reminders

All clothing and items brought into pre-school should be clearly labelled. This includes scooters and bikes that are brought in from home.

Labels can be purchased from <u>www.stikins.co.uk</u>. If you input our fundraising code – 10330 – we receive a percentage of money for each sale.

In the mornings, scooters & bikes should be left in the bike shed on the way into pre-school and we kindly ask that they are not used in the playground when lining up.

We understand that some children may want to bring in familiar toys from home, particularly at the start of the term, but we politely ask that they are kept to a minimal and, where possible, should be topic related.

Weather permitting, weekly Learning Walks will continue, and we will visit the park, dell or aerodrome. Could you please provide a bag of suitable clothing to include wellies and a puddle suit that can be left throughout the term on your child's peg. Clothing should be clearly labelled with their name.

Hunsdon Ducklings aims to be a <u>Nut-Free Pre-school.</u>

This policy serves to set out all measures to reduce the risk to those children and adults who may suffer an anaphylactic reaction if exposed to nuts to which they are sensitive. Therefore, we do not allow nuts or nut products in lunch boxes.

Could we politely request that grapes, olives & tomatoes are cut up lengthways when in packed lunchboxes

Your child's memories, milestones and achievements are gathered during their time with us at Ducklings and are presented in their Learning Journey books. These are personal to them and gives a picture of how your child has learnt and developed during the beginning of their early years education.

The children get to take these home at the end of their time with Ducklings, but we offer an open-door policy and welcome parents/carers to make an appointment to come and have a chat with your child's keyworker, have a look through the learning journey and to discuss their progression.

We also issue Unique Child Summaries at the end of each term which gives an overview of your child's progress during that term. They also outline the next steps that we will be working to with them and suggestions of how you can support your child with them at home.



SHOW & TELL

Show & Tell gives your child the opportunity to bring in something relevant to the topic for that week e.g. a book, toy, picture, object or an event which they will share with their peers and staff during the week. We have also given suggestions for things you can do at home to promote and support your child's learning. If some weeks you do not have anything relevant, please do not worry as we have many resources the children can share.

Visit The Gruffalo Trail (Thorndon Lodge, 29 Brentwood Rd, Ingrave, Warley, Brentwood CM13 3RE) and send in photos of your visit

Week commencing 7th October - Autumn

Go on a walk and collect Autumnal objects. Bring them into school for carpet time conversation.

Week commencing 14th October - Autumn

Make a den and pretend to hibernate – send in photos

Week commencing 21st October – Autumn Paint a picture of a pumpkin (2d) or be creative and make a 3d model of a pumpkin
