SHOW & TELL

Show & Tell gives your child the opportunity to bring in something relevant to the topic for that week e.g. a book, toy, picture, object or an event which they will share with their peers and staff during the week. We have also given suggestions for things you can do at home to promote and support your child's learning. If some weeks you do not have anything relevant, please do not worry as we have many resources the children can share.

Week commencing 3rd June – Space

- Ask your child to draw the eight planets (circles) in the Solar System and colour them in, helping to promote fine motor skills, counting, mathematical language of size and shape.

Week commencing 10th June - Space

- Can you make a model or drawing of a rocket? Talk about the 2d and 3d shapes used.

Week commencing 17th June – How People Help Us

- Talk to your child about the different types of people that help within the community. Can they name those that help us? Ask questions – what do they do? where do they work? what do they wear? Ask your child what they'd like to be when they grow up.

Week commencing 24th June - Occupation Week

- We will be having visitors in this week to speak to the children about their jobs. Speak to your child about their day and who visited them to see what they can recall.

Week commencing 1st July – Sports Week

- We hope you can cheer on your child from the sidelines when they participate in Sports Day

Week commencing 8th July – Goldilocks and the Three Bears

- Three is the magic number! Can your child make the table for three of their teddies using three bowls, three spoons and three chairs.
- Can they draw the different sized bears, small, medium and large.
